### Why would you use a custom application form?

- Create new people
- Edit existing people
- Read-only/view existing people

## **Setting up a custom applications** - Setup panel -> Custom applications

- Edit existing forms
- New form
  - Built-in design Right-click -> Copy
  - Blank design Create a new design link
  - From a disk file Opens an application sent by another VSys user
  - From another project

#### Using the designer

#### **Data Fields**

- Inserting data field
- Editing a field
  - Move Click on the field (not the label) and drag/drop
  - Resize Click and pull the corner squares
  - o Properties Click on the field, make changes on the left panel
  - Align fields Alignment buttons along the top
  - Add a page

**User fields** - User fields allow you to add whatever field labels you want to a new field. Unlike data fields, user fields do not affect or use data outside of the custom application form itself, with the exception of the *special field types* (below).

- Inserting a user field
- Types of fields
  - Label Text to be read on the application (no input)
  - Memo space to enter a block of text
  - <u>Text</u> space to enter one line of text
  - o <u>Date</u>
  - <u>List/checklist</u>
  - o Others

- Special user fields
  - HTML label HTML labels let you embed HTML text within a VSys Web or VSys Live application. Right-click on your label and select Edit text to edit the HTML in that label.
  - Availability
  - Job slot selection This type of field represents an opening for a job, and allows your volunteers to select jobs via the web, but only openings which still require volunteers

## **Application properties**

- Basics (name, types, inactive)
- Add/remove from list
- Dates
- Types of applications
  - Normal
  - o VSys Web
  - VSys Live
- Default status
- Read-only, show in lookup tool, show on main VSys screen
- Web/Live options
