VSys Tools:

Accounts and Outcomes: What we want to track to show how we are influencing. Counts of things.

Communities Served: Hours and volunteers connected to communities or initiatives Job Value: Monetary value for the task being done

Example Scenario:

A hospital with two "improvement" initiatives:

- 1) Patient/Family Services
 - Coffee cove
 - How many cups of coffee served
 - Information Desk volunteer
 - How many queries answered (contacts)
- 2) Patient Experience
 - Patient Book cart
 - How many books delivered
 - How many patient contacts
 - Pet Therapy
 - How many patient visits

Accounts and Outcomes:

Enable the feature under System preferences and feature enabling -> Feature enabling

Create the Account types, then set up the account/outcomes.

- Setup -> Accounts and outcomes -> Setup account types
- Setup -> Accounts and outcomes -> Add account/outcome

Link the Account/outcome to the specific job

Setup -> Job and job group definitions -> Associated accounts

Communities served:

Create the Communities

Setup -> Jobs -> Communities served -> Add communities served

Link the Community to the specific job

Setup -> Jobs -> Job and job group definitions -> Communities served

Job values:

Create the *Job value* (Globally)

• Setup -> System preferences and feature enabling -> Jobs -> Hourly values

Link the *Job value* to the *specific job*

Setup -> Jobs -> Job and job group definitions -> Job value

Tips and hints:

After setting up the *Accounts/outcomes* and the *Communities served* use the Bulk Value Updater to add them to the Job Descriptions. Make sure to make a backup first!

For Pet Therapy positions - Decide on one "individual" to record the visits. Separate jobs allow you to see a more accurate time/visit ratio.
